Handelsbanken Farnham is closing on 4 October 2024

Following a careful review we have made the difficult decision to close Farnham branch on 4 October 2024.

The team will relocate and combine with the team at our Guildford branch.

We will write to any customers affected by this decision, as well as other stakeholders.

Why is this happening?

We're committed to our branch-based business model and our branches will always be fundamental to how we run our decentralised bank and how we engage with our customers.

However, we need to evolve and adapt our business in line with changing customer behaviour and demands. Part of this adaptation involves making adjustments to our branch network to ensure we continue to be represented in the right areas to serve our customers in the best possible way.

The initial consideration to close the branch was taken on economic grounds, and the detailed analysis took into account:

- Customer impact and customer outcomes
- · Long-term viability and opportunities for the branch
- Our environmental footprint

We believe that by joining resources with Guildford branch, customers will be able to make better use of the expertise from colleagues across a wider team, which means greater service and support.

What this means for customers of Farnham branch

If you're a customer of Farnham branch, you'll move to our Guildford branch from 4 October 2024. If your account manager is changing, we'll write to tell you.

Following the closure you'll start to see the new branch name and address on your centrally produced banking correspondence and digital banking.

Getting there

Farnham branch premises are located at M1 Millennium Centre and Guildford branch premises are located close to Guildford town centre, which is 12 miles away.

Public transport

Guildford branch has good public transport links, with the closest bus stop located outside the Friary Bus Station, Guildford, GU1 4PU, a two minute walk to the branch. The journey time by public transport on the bus network is approximately 29 minutes and the bus stop is approximately two minutes' walk from Farnham branch

The closest train station is Guildford Rail Station, GU1 4UT, which is located about half a mile or a 10 minute walk away. Alternatively, travel by National Rail involves a 23 minute journey between Farnham Rail Station and Guildford Rail Station, stopping at Aldershot, Ash and Wanborough.

Parking

For those customers wishing to drive to Guildford branch, there are several large public car parks located nearby, with the nearest being a three minute walk away and the furthest a 12 minute walk away. The branch is located on the ground floor and, as such, is easily accessible.

The branch is open Monday - Friday between 9am and 5pm, the same as Farnham branch.
