Handelsbanken Gateshead is closing during Quarter 1 2025

Following a careful review we have made the difficult decision to close our Gateshead branch during Quarter 1 2025.

The team will relocate and combine with our team at Newcastle upon Tyne branch.

Why is this happening?

We're committed to our branch-based business model and our branches will always be fundamental to how we run our decentralised bank and how we engage with our customers.

However, we need to evolve and adapt our business in line with changing customer behaviour and demands. Part of this adaptation involves making adjustments to our branch network to ensure we continue to be represented in the right areas to serve our customers in the best possible way.

We believe that by joining resources with Newcastle upon Tyne branch, customers will benefit. We'll be able to make better use of the expertise from colleagues across a wider team, which means greater service and support.

What this means for customers of Gateshead branch

If you're a customer of Gateshead you'll move to our Newcastle upon Tyne branch during Quarter 1 2025. If your account manager is changing, we'll write to tell you.

Getting there

Newcastle upon Tyne branch is located five miles from Gateshead branch, which is approximately 20 minutes by car.

Public transport

Newcastle branch is located on Gallowgate and has good public transport links, with local bus stops less than a one minute walk (110 ft) from the branch. St James Metro station is a one minute walk (312 ft) from the branch. Travelling by Metro between Gateshead and St James station takes approximately 10 minutes. Newcastle Central Railway Station is a 10 minute walk away (0.5 miles).

Parking

For those customers wishing to drive to Newcastle branch, there are several large paid public car parks located nearby, with the nearest being a three minute walk away and the furthest being a 10 minute walk away.

Opening hours and accessibility

The branch is open Monday - Friday between 9am and 5pm, the same as Gateshead branch.

The branch is accessed through the ground floor reception at Citygate 1 and then via a lift or stairs to the 6th floor.

Our service remains the same

The wider team will stay the same, and we'll continue to offer the same products and services.

Your sort code and account number(s), and existing Handelsbanken Debit and/or Charge Card(s) won't change, so you won't need replacement chequebooks or any new stationery.

There's no change to how you use our online banking services and mobile banking apps.
