is closing during Spring 2025.

Following a careful review we have made the difficult decision to close our Newport branch during Spring 2025.

The team will relocate and combine with our team at Cardiff branch.

Why is this happening?

We're committed to our branch-based business model and our branches will always be fundamental to how we run our decentralised bank and how we engage with our customers.

However, we need to evolve and adapt our business in line with changing customer behaviour and demands. Part of this adaptation involves making adjustments to our branch network to ensure we continue to be represented in the right areas to serve our customers in the best possible way.

We believe that by combining the resources of our branch and Cardiff branch, you'll benefit from continuity of service and the expertise from colleagues across a wider team, such as our wealth management specialists.

What this means for customers of Newport branch

If you're a customer of Newport branch you'll move to our Cardiff branch during Spring 2025.

Following the move you'll start to see the new branch name and address on your centrally produced banking correspondence and digital banking. We've ensured that any emails you send to the old branch email address will be redirected to the new branch.

We'll be in touch again nearer the time to let you know the exact dates of the move.

Getting there:

Public transport

The closest bus stop to Cardiff branch is located at Callaghan Square and is a two minute walk to the branch. The journey time by public transport on the bus network between Newport and Cardiff is approximately 88 minutes. The closest train station is Cardiff Central, which is located about 0.2 miles (a five minute walk) away. There is a direct train between Newport station and Cardiff Central station which takes 12 minutes.

Parking

Newport branch is a 45 minute drive from Cardiff branch via the M4 and A48(M).

For those customers wishing to drive to Cardiff branch, there are several large paid public car parks located nearby, with the nearest being a four minute walk away and the furthest an eight minute walk away.

Opening hours and accessibility

Cardiff branch is open Monday - Friday between 9am and 5pm, the same as Newport branch.

Cardiff branch also has improved accessibility, as the branch is located on the ground floor of a communal building.

Our service remains the same

The wider team will stay the same, and we'll continue to offer the same products and services.

Your sort code and account number(s), and existing Handelsbanken Debit and/or Charge Card(s) won't change, so you won't need replacement chequebooks or any new stationery.

There's no change to how you use our online banking services and mobile banking apps.

- **Handelsbanken Clifton** – 2nd Floor, Pembroke House, 15 Pembroke Rd, Clifton, Bristol, BS8 3BA, which is 24.8 miles away from the existing branch location and 43.8 miles from the new branch location.
